### Bizarre server behavior

- □ Seems to occur after server code crashes
- □ Old versions of the Web sites get served, from caches somewhere
- □ Solution: restart the server.

sudo /usr/bin/systemctl restart httpd.service

- □ Does not seem to interfere with others' work
- □ Might be a problem on Tuesday night

# Checking input data on the server

- Always necessary since crazy HTTP requests can come in from anywhere.
- □ Example: time (date should be similar)

- harness program moves url into environ dictionary, calls your application() function.
